General Meeting Minutes – 5 April 2016

Commandant: Commandant Dominic D'Alessandro opened the meeting at 1930. The regular opening ceremonies were conducted. Officers present were Commandant Dominic D'Alessandro, Sr. Vice Commandant Dominick Mattioni, Jr. Vice Commandant Jack McLeod, Judge Advocate Bernie McGinley, Paymaster Bob Spano, Adjutant Jack Kelly, Chaplain Chris Bush, Sergeant-at-Arms Charles (Bud) Davis, Service Officer Jim Herbst, Director Paul Donohue, Director Roger Godfrey, and Director Bill Kinney.

Introduction of New Member: A potential new member was introduced by Aleta Krauss. Scott Chambers had served in the U.S. Air Force. After hearing some introductory comments, Jim Herbst made a motion to accept Scott Chambers as an associate member of the Detachment. Bernie McGinley seconded the motion and the motion passed. Commandant Dominic D'Alessandro administered the oath of membership and Scott Chambers was sworn in as an associate member of the Detachment.

Minutes: George Boyajian made a motion to accept the minutes of the 1 March 2016 general meeting as published in the *Scuttlebutt*. Paul Donohue seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Officer Reports:

Adjutant: Jack Kelly reported that letters of thanks for donations made by the Detachment had been received from the Semper Fi Fund in Oceanside, CA, from the Fisher House Foundation in Rockville, MD, and from the Liberty USO in Philadelphia, PA. A letter of thanks was also received from the Grand Canyon Runners Association in Sedona, AZ. This latter organization was a new organization that the Detachment had donated to recently.

Jr. Vice Commandant: Dominick Mattioni provided information on the 7 June 2016 Scholarship Awards Dinner Meeting. The cost is \$12.00 per person and signup sheets were available for members to sign up for the meeting.

Jr. Vice Commandant: Jack McLeod provided a brief explanation of the Detachment's fund raising activities for the benefit of our new member and a guest who was present. He outlined the Help Us Help Others (HUHO) Campaign, the Help Our Heroes Campaign, and the purpose behind the Ball Program Book as a fundraising medium in November of each year. The Help Us Help Others Campaign is the major fundraiser for the Detachment.

Paymaster: Bob Spano reviewed the paymaster's report as of 31 March 2016. He also suggested that the membership review the list of organizations on the back of the agenda that would be discussed later in the meeting. These organizations had been discussed at a recent officers' staff meeting and were being suggested to the membership for consideration.

Chaplain: Chris Bush mentioned that Tom Kerrigan would be hospitalized in the near future for a procedure. Depending on the results, it may be necessary for him to have another procedure. Chris Bush asked the membership to remember Tom Kerrigan in their thoughts and prayers. Chris Bush mentioned that Wes Tomlinson was ill and should also be remembered. Chris Bush mentioned that the daughter of Ollie McGraw, a member who had passed away recently, had contacted Chris and she mentioned that she appreciated all that Chris and the membership had done for her father.

Service Officer: Jim Herbst reported that there had been a St. Patrick's Day party at the Coatesville Medical Center and about sixty-five veterans attended the event. Jim Herbst and Con McGinley assisted with the party. In addition, Jim Herbst mentioned that a bingo game is scheduled for 14 April 2016 at the Coatesville Medical Center.

Director Kinney: Bill Kinney reported on the flag lowering and raising activity at the Delaware County Veterans Memorial in Newtown Square, PA. The flag was recently lowered for the funeral of Mrs. Nancy Reagan and also following the terrorist attack in Brussels, Belgium. Bill Kinney mentioned that one of our members, Joe Daly, would be honored on 6 April 2016 at 1000 at the Delaware County Court House along with several other honorees. It was also mentioned that a Color Guard would be needed on 7 April for a ground breaking ceremony for the Hall of Prayer at the Delaware County Veterans Memorial. Bill Kinney also provided information on "Rockin With The Troops," a show scheduled for 30 April 2016, including singer Bobby Rydell and others. He also provided information on a trail run scheduled for 22 May 2016. More information will be provided on this at a later date.

Committee Reports:

Adopt-a-Highway: Jim Flynn mentioned that the first Adopt-a-Highway event for the year is scheduled for 24 April 2016, with a report time of 0830.

Americanism: Earle Drake reported that Flag History Presentations will be made at the Hillcrest School on 18 May 2016 and a Color Day program will be held at the Stonehurst School on 27 May 2016. Earle Drake mentioned that the Villanova University NROTC Spring Review will be held on 19 April 2016. A reception is scheduled for 1400 in the Ward Room and the ceremony will begin at 1500 in front of John Barry Hall. The Detachment has reserved eight seats for the program. The Detachment will award its "Gung Ho" award to Midshipman 1/C Owen Fallon, who has been identified as one who has demonstrated the drive and aggressiveness that characterizes the Marine Officer. Earle Drake also mentioned that two Detachment members, Tom McGovern and Bill Kinney, will be awarded the Chapel of Four Chaplains Legion of Honor Award. The presentations will be made in July. Membership in the Legion of Honor of the Four Chaplains is awarded on the basis of documented acts of selfless service, consisting of deeds and actions on behalf of others irrespective of their race, ethnicity, or faith.

Awards: Jim Herbst briefly explained the history of the Commandant's Award, and along with Commandant Dominic D'Alessandro, Jim Herbst announced that the recipient of the 2015 Commandant's Award is Roger Godfrey. Junior Past Commandant Paul Ferguson was not in attendance, so the award was presented to Roger Godfrey "for performance of duties and services above and beyond those required." Other comments were also made in reference to the selection of Roger Godfrey as the recipient of the Commandant's Award for 2015. Jim Herbst also presented Roger Godfrey with a Meritorious Commendation certificate for fundraising in 2015.

Color Guard: Wayne Williams reported that the Springfield St Patrick's Day Parade was a huge success and thousands people witnessed the parade. The Detachment Color Guard participated in the parade, and the members involved were Jerry McGuckin, Bob Wells, Jack Kelly, Bob Spano and Wayne Williams. Wayne Williams mentioned that a Color Guard would be needed on 15 April 2016 at 1800 at the Paxon Hollow Country Club. Members interested in participating were asked to contact Wayne Williams.

Honor Guard: Ben Sides mentioned that there were twelve veterans who were honored with military funerals during the month of March 2016. The year-to-date total was given as thirty-six. Five more funerals are scheduled for the current week. Ben Sides also mentioned that there is still a need for someone to volunteer to be the next Honor Guard Chairman. It was also mentioned that a back-up person is also needed, one who could take the calls from the funeral directors.

Marksmanship: Paul Drinkard mentioned that the Marine Corps League pistol shoot is scheduled for 4 and 5 June 2016 at Indiantown Gap, PA. Four shooters have already committed to participate, but if there are any others interested in shooting, they should contact Paul Drinkard, Earle Drake, or Bob Spano.

Membership: Jim Herbst again expressed the need for members to be involved in recruiting new members.

Property: Bob Spano mentioned that he would be ordering sweatshirts or golf shirts. The shirts are available in various sizes and a number of colors. This evening would be the last evening to order the shirts before Bob Spano places the order.

Communications: John Burfete mentioned that he would be sending out an e-mail on some upcoming activities.

Scholarships: Wayne Williams reported that he has received nine applications for Detachment scholarships. He reminded the membership that the deadline for Detachment scholarship applications is 15 April 2016. He also mentioned that the deadline for the the Department of Pennsylvania scholarship program is 31 May 2016, and the MCL National Scholarship program deadline is 1 July 2016.

Unfinished Business: No items of unfinished business were raised.

Good of the League: Jim Herbst mentioned that there will be another Walk for the Wounded event this year in May.

He will not be able to participate this year, but he would like to see some members step up and volunteer to man the tent and try to recruit some new members. A Color Guard will also be needed for this event. Additional information will be presented at the May general meeting.

Commandant Dominic D'Alessandro mentioned that a plaque will be presented to Sgt. Travis Romenesko of the Folsom Reserve Unit for his outstanding work with the Young Marines. Sgt. Romenesko has received orders for a new duty station, so the plaque will be awarded to him on 13 April 2016 at 1830 at the Folsom Reserve Center. Anyone interested in attending is welcome.

New Business:

Charitable Donations: Bob Spano reviewed the list of organizations being suggested for donations. These had been discussed at a recent officers' staff meeting. Earle Drake also provided information on one listed as the Upper Darby Marine Corps League Detachment. The purpose of this was to assist with the MCL PT program in an annual event in San Diego, CA. Youngsters throughout the United States gather there to compete in PT events, and youngsters from Delaware County have been successful in the past in this program. Paul Donohue made a motion to donate the funds as outlined. The organizations and the amounts to be donated in parentheses are (1) Fisher House Foundation, Rockville, MD (\$2,000.00); (2) The Injured Marine Semper Fi Fund, Oceanside, CA (\$2,000.00); (3) Operation First Response, Inc., Culpeper, VA (\$2,000.00); (4) Operation Homefront, Doylestown, PA (\$1,000.00); (5) Society of St. Vincent DePaul, Havertown, PA (\$1,000.00); (6) Upper Darby Marine Corps League Detachment (youth PT program) (\$500.00); and (7) The USO, Philadelphia International Airport, Philadelphia, PA (\$2,000.00). Harry Kaufman seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Announcements: No announcements were mentioned.

George Boyajian made a motion to adjourn the meeting, and the motion was seconded by several members. After the regular closing ceremonies, the meeting was adjourned at 2025. Joe Conigliaro won the 50/50. Thirty-four members signed the logbook.
