General Meeting Minutes – 2 September 2014

Commandant: Commandant Paul Ferguson called the meeting to order at 1930. The regular opening ceremonies were conducted. Officers present were Commandant Paul Ferguson, Sr. Vice Commandant Dominic D'Alessandro, Jr. Vice Commandant Jack McLeod, Judge Advocate Bernie McGinley, Paymaster Bob Spano, Adjutant Jack Kelly, Chaplain Chris Bush, Sergeant-at-Arms Charles (Bud) Davis, Service Officer Con McGinley, Director Roger Godfrey, Director Bill Kinney, Director Ed Seidl, and Jr. Past Commandant Jim Herbst. Paul Ferguson asked the guests in the meeting to stand, and guests included Charlie Chamberlain, Past Commandant of the All Divisions Detachment, George Souder, Past Commandant of the Upper Darby Detachment, Fred LeClair, Past Commandant of the Chester County Detachment, and Ben Napier, Commander of the local VFW.

Fred LeClair presented four Certificates of Appreciation from the MCL Department of Pennsylvania to Commandant Paul Ferguson. Two were for Dan Luty (not present) for his contributions to the Detachment's website and also for his work as editor of the Detachment's newsletter, the *Scuttlebutt*. Two other Certificates of Appreciation were for the Detachment's newsletter, the *Scuttlebutt* and the Detachment's participation in the Scouting program. Fred LeClair also provided some information on the Devil Dog program. Due to some restructuring within Districts, the Chester County Devil Dog Pound will be moved from District One to District Two in the Department of Pennsylvania. Fred LeClair mentioned that the Devil Dogs are the Honor Society of the Marine Corps League, and members have to be asked to join the Devil Dogs, and approved by their Commandant. The Chester County Pound is named the Albert E. Smith Detachment and it meets in the home of the Chester County MCL Detachment in Downingtown, PA.

Minutes: George Boyajian made a motion to accept the minutes of the 5 August 2014 general meeting as published in the *Scuttlebutt*. Jim Donegan seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Officer Reports:

Commandant: Commandant Paul Ferguson mentioned that Bob Cosgrove would not be heading up the annual Toys for Tots program this year. He asked the membership for a volunteer to handle the program this year. No one volunteered immediately.

Adjutant: Jack Kelly mentioned that a thank you note had been received from the family of Barry Reese, signed by Annette and Anne Marie Reese, thanking the Detachment for the Honor Guard ceremony at the funeral of Barry Reese, our long time member and Commander of the VFW. Jack Kelly also mentioned that a letter of thanks for a contribution had been received from the Semper Fi Fund in Oceanside, CA, and a card of thanks for a donation made by the Detachment had been received from the St. Vincent DePaul Society in Havertown, PA. Two upcoming golf tournaments were mentioned. One was for a golf classic on 29 September 2014 sponsored by the Upper Darby Detachment at the Springfield Country Club, and a second was for an event on 4 October 2014, sponsored by the Scotland School for Veterans Children. This event was scheduled for the Eagles Crossing Golf Club in Carlisle, PA. Informational flyers on both events would be available for review following the meeting.

Sr. Vice Commandant: Dominic D'Alessandro mentioned that the Detachment's Marine Corps Birthday Ball is scheduled for Friday, 14 November 2014 at the Paxon Hollow Country Club. The cost is \$45.00 per person.

Those planning to attend should give their money for the event to Bob Spano. John Cook is handling reservations and seating arrangements.

Jr. Vice Commandant: Jack McLeod mentioned that \$6,974.00 had been collected in the Help Us Help Others (HUHO) Campaign over the Labor Day Weekend. In 2013, about \$6,000.00 had been collected, so this year's amount surpassed the amount for the Labor Day weekend for the prior year. Jack McLeod mentioned that several members and Auxiliary members had done multiple shifts over the Labor Day weekend, and he recognized Betty Bunce, Nancy Bassett, John Burfete, Bud Davis, Sissy Hudson, Dom Mattioni, Rick Guyer, Paul Ferguson and George Boyajian for their contributions of doing multiple shifts over the weekend. Jack McLeod also mentioned that at a comparable time period in 2013, \$81,000.00 had been collected in the HUHO Campaign. So far this year, more than \$113,000.00 has been collected in the HUHO Campaign.

Chaplain: Chris Bush mentioned that Ollie McGraw and Bob Stanton had both been hospitalized recently. He also mentioned that John Haynal now has a new aide with the Veterans Administration following a recent situation.

Service Officer: Con McGinley mentioned that there is a bingo game at the Coatesville Medical Center this Thursday, 4 September, and a picnic is scheduled at the Coatesville Medical Center for Saturday, 6 September 2014.

Paymaster: Bob Spano provided information on the paymaster's report as of 31 August 2014. He also mentioned the list of charitable organizations that were listed on the back of the meeting agenda. He suggested that the members review this list which will be considered for donations later in the meeting. George Boyajian made a motion to accept the paymaster's report as received. Bernie McGinley seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Jr. Past Commandant: Jr. Past Commandant Jim Herbst reminded the membership that nominations for Detachment officers will begin during the October general meeting. Nominations can also be made in the November and December general meetings, with the election of officers taking place in the December general meeting. He reviewed the eligibility requirements for the officer positions, and then encouraged the membership to consider the officer positions. He also mentioned that a volunteer is needed for the Toys for Tots program as well as for the position of Flag Collections chairman.

Director Kinney: Bill Kinney provided information on the first annual awards dinner sponsored by the Delaware County Veterans Memorial Association in which two Detachment members, Con McGinley and Tom McGovern, will be honored, among others. Tom McGovern will be honored for his service during World War II and Con McGinley will be honored for his service in Korea. The dinner is scheduled for 13 November 2014 at the Springfield Country Club. The Detachment will be supplying a Color Guard for this event. Bill Kinney also reviewed ticket information and ticket costs for this event. Bill Kinney also discussed activities on Veterans Day in November, including the earlier events that day as well as the annual parade in Media, PA. He also mentioned that on 27 September 2014, Channel 29 TV News will be broadcasting from the Delaware County Veterans Memorial, with Sue Serio of Fox 29 News doing occasional cut-ins from the Memorial.

Committee Reports:

Adopt-a-Highway: John Burfete mentioned that the third Adopt-a-Highway event had been held recently, with an acceptable turnout of volunteers. Enough individuals were there to accomplish the task of cleaning up trash along Bishop Hollow Road in Newtown Square, PA.

Americanism: Earle Drake reported that an Americanism/Flag History presentation had been made at the Maris Grove Retirement Community in Glen Mills, PA. The presentation was made to about seventy-five members of the Veterans Club at Maris Grove. MCL members giving the presentation were Earle Drake, Jim Mulhern and Lloyd Spangler. Charlie Coombs also participated, speaking about his exploits as an FMF corpsman in Vietnam. Also attending the meeting were Linda Houlden and Karen Comfort of the Delaware County Historical Society. Earle Drake mentioned that the Americanism team will be participating with the Delaware County Historical Society in the near future. The team will also be making a presentation to the Rotary Club of Bethel, PA. Elementary schools are being contacted for the purpose of making presentations during the school year. In other matters, Earle Drake mentioned that the Walk for Babies event is scheduled for 28 September 2014, at 0900, at Front and Monroe Streets in Media, PA. In addition, the Detachment has reserved some time at the Springfield Library for an exhibit in July 2015. The Marine Corps League directory (dated 2010) at this meeting was donated by Walt Tallmadge.

Awards: Jim Herbst reminded committee chairman to begin thinking of names of those members who have assisted in Detachment events this year, and to send the list of names to those who should receive recognition to Jim Herbst. Since it takes time to prepare the certificates, Jim Herbst mentioned that the names of those to be recognized should be submitted by the November general meeting.

Color Guard: Jim Donegan provided information on upcoming activities for the Color Guard. Volunteers for the Color Guard for the Delaware County Veterans Memorial Association dinner were Jim Donegan, Wayne Williams, Jack Kelly, Jim Herbst and Paul Ferguson. Jim Donegan also mentioned an upcoming event at Martin's Run, a retirement community in Media, PA scheduled for 30 September 2014. There is also an event at the helicopter museum in West Chester scheduled for 11 and 12 October 2014. The Color Guard will be needed to open the event on Sunday, 12 October, but the need is less certain for the event on Saturday, 11 October. This will be looked into further. Jim Donegan also mentioned that the reimbursement from the U.S. Army to the Combined Veterans Alliance for services performed at funerals is still being held up in paperwork. This is being looked into and it hopefully will be resolved shortly.

Delaware County Veterans Memorial Park: Bill Kinney mentioned that a meeting is coming up at the Newtown Township Building concerning Phase Two construction on the prayer chapel. The date of the meeting is not certain, but as more information is developed, Bill Kinney will try to keep the membership informed.

Property: Bob Spano mentioned that the framed picture of General Smedley D. Butler had the glass broken, so the picture is being reframed with new glass.

Scouting: Ed Seidl mentioned that an Eagle Scout awards presentation had been made in August. Another is coming up in November.

Unfinished Business: No items of unfinished business were raised.

New Business: Charlie Chamberlain of the All Divisions Detachment mentioned that the annual Beirut Memorial Service will be held on 26 October 2014. All MCL members are invited to attend.

Paul Donohue provided information on a possible fishing trip. Trips out of Sea Isle City or out of Cape May, NJ were mentioned as possibilities. Interested members should contact Paul Donohue.

Bob Spano reviewed the list of organizations that were being suggested for donations this month. These had been discussed at a recent officers' staff meeting and were being recommended to the membership for consideration. George Boyajian made a motion to donate the funds as outlined on the back of the agenda. Bernie McGinley seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Good of the League: Since Tom McGovern and Con McGinley are being honored at the Delaware County Veterans Memorial Association dinner, Bill Kinney made a motion for the Detachment to take out a full color ad in the ad booklet that will be used at the Delaware County Veterans Memorial Association dinner. The cost of the full color ad is \$500.00. Earle Drake seconded the motion and the motion passed.

George Boyajian made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Bernie McGinley seconded the motion and the motion passed. After the regular closing ceremonies, the meeting was adjourned at 2030.
