#### General Meeting Minutes – 4 April 2017

Commandant: Commandant Dominic D'Alessandro opened the meeting at 1930. The regular opening ceremonies were conducted. Officers present were Dominic D'Alessandro, Sr. Vice Commandant Dominick Mattioni, Judge Advocate Earle Drake, Paymaster Bob Spano, Adjutant Jack Kelly, Chaplain Chris Bush, Sergeant-at-Arms Charles (Bud) Davis, Service Officer Jim Herbst, Director Jim Flynn, and Director Bill Kinney.

Minutes: George Boyajian made a motion to accept the minutes of the 7 March 2017 general meeting as published in the *Scuttlebutt*. Jim Flynn seconded the motion and the motion passed.

#### Officer Reports:

Adjutant: Jack Kelly reported that letters of appreciation for donations made by the Detachment had been received from the Liberty USO at the Philadelphia International Airport, from the Fisher House Foundation in Rockville, MD, from the Semper Fi Fund in Oceanside, CA, and from The Luzerne Foundation, Luzerne, PA.

Senior Vice Commandant: Dominick Mattioni reported that he had signup sheets available for the Spring Dinner, scheduled for 6 June 2017. He also had signup sheets available for the District One Meeting scheduled for 30 April 2017. The District One Meeting will be held at the Knight of Columbus in Newtown Square, PA, beginning at 1400. Dominick Mattioni also mentioned that reminders on these two meetings will be sent out to the membership by email.

Judge Advocate: Earle Drake, in his capacity of Americanism Chairman, mentioned that the Americanism team would be making an Americanism/Flag History presentation at the Loomis School in Broomall on 4 May 2017. He also mentioned that 23 April 2017 is the date for the Spring Pistol Match. Approximately thirty-one members from five MCL Detachments will be shooting. The start time is 0900, but shooters are asked to arrive early to help put up the targets. It was also mentioned that the Service and Open Pistol Match will be held on Saturday, 10 June 2017 at Indiantown Gap, PA. Hold Harmless agreements and team registration forms are to be sent to Gene Kern, captain of the team. The deadline for signing up is 31 May 2017.

In his capacity of Judge Advocate, Earle Drake had reviewed the new Administrative Procedure and he had found that the new procedure is specific to our Detachment and appeared to not conflict with the Department or National By-laws or Administrative Procedures. Copies of the new proposed procedure were reviewed by the membership and approved by the membership at the previous general meeting.

Earle Drake also had distributed brochures on the Chapel of Four Chaplains organization. He mentioned that if any member desired to nominate a person for the Chapel of Four Chaplains

award to see him after the meeting.

Paymaster: Bob Spano provided the paymaster's report as of 31 March 2017. He reviewed the income as well as the expenses for the month. He asked the membership to review the the list of organizations suggested for donations this month, listed on the back of the agenda. These organizations would be considered later in the meeting. George Boyajian made a motion to accept the paymaster's report as received. Bernie McKinley seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Chaplain: Chris Bush mentioned that he did not know of any member being ill, but he did recognize three members who had not been to general meetings recently. Chris Bush mentioned that it was good to see Joe Conigliaro, Bernie McGinley, and Bill Kinney at this meeting.

Junior Vice Commandant: Jack McLeod was not in attendance at the meeting, but Commandant Dominic D'Alessandro provided information on the Help Us Help Others (HUHO) Campaign. Dominic D'Alessandro mentioned that \$4,799.00 had been collected in the prior weekend, and the year-to-date total now stood at \$10,500.00 in collections from area shoppers. It was mentioned that appreciation was extended to all the members who had participated in the program so far.

Service Officer: Jim Herbst mentioned that he and Con McKinley had assisted with the St. Patrick's Party and bingo at the Coatesville Medical Center in March. There were three members there from the Chester County MCL Detachment, and the General Smedley D. Butler Auxiliary was also present, assisting with treats. More than one hundred veterans were at the party and prizes were distributed at the event. In his role as Awards Chairman, Jim Herbst awarded a Meritorious Commendation to Bernie McKinley. He also awarded a Meritorious Commendation to Sam Mayer. Jim Herbst also stressed the importance of recruiting, saying "We need people."

Director Kinney: Bill Kinney provided information for those members involved in raising and lowering the flags at the Delaware County Veterans Memorial. He also provided information on the upcoming event, "Rockin' With the Troops," scheduled for 22 April 2017 at Neumann University. Bill Kinney indicated that some tickets were available, but members needed to contact him after the meeting. He also discussed the casket flag ceremonies at the Delaware County Veterans Memorial, discussing the schedule and also mentioning that the start time this year will be 1700 for all casket flag ceremonies.

Director Flynn: Jim Flynn did not have a report as a Director, but he mentioned that the first Adopt-a- Highway event is scheduled for 30 April 2017. An email will be sent out as the date draws closer, but volunteers are always needed for this responsibility.

#### Committee Reports:

Historian: Jack Gallagher mentioned that progress is being made on the history book.



Home Association: Tom Kerrigan reported that things were quiet on this front.

Honor Guard: Ben Sides reported that there were seventeen military funerals for deceased veterans during the month of March, and the year to date total stands at forty-one. Ben Sides emphasized that help is urgently needed, as sometimes there are just a small number of participants in the Honor Guard. Anyone interested in participating in the Honor Guard should contact Ben Sides.

Property: Bob Spano mentioned that new flags had been placed on the pole outside of the Knights of Columbus building.

Unfinished Business: No items of unfinished business were raised.

New Business:

Charitable Organizations: Bob Spano reviewed the organizations listed on the back of the agenda which were being suggested for donations this month. These organizations were recently discussed at an officers' staff meeting and were being suggested for consideration. Bob Spano mentioned that the donation for Justine's Cuisines was not for her catering business but the donation, if approved, would go to her efforts in feeding the homeless in Delaware County. Every Wednesday Justine feeds approximately seventy-five people who are less fortunate, and the donation would go toward that endeavor. He also reviewed the need for funds for the Upper Darby MCL and its involvement with the Youth Physical Fitness Program. George Boyajian made a motion to donate the funds as outlined on the back of the agenda. The organizations and the amounts to be donated are: (1) Fisher House Foundation, Rockville, MD (\$3,000.00); (2) The Injured Marine Semper Fi Fund, Oceanside, CA (\$3,000.00); (3) Justine's Cuisines, Broomall, PA (\$1,000.00); (4) Operation First Response, Culpeper, VA (\$3,000.00); (5) Upper Darby Detachment Marine Corps League, Upper Darby, PA (\$1,000.00); and (6) The USO, Philadelphia International Airport, Philadelphia, PA (\$3,000.00). Several members seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Good of the League: Ben Sides mentioned that if any member was interested in participating in the flag raising at the Delaware County Veterans Memorial and wanted to learn how to fold the flag, the member should contact Ben. He would teach anyone interested in how to fold the flag for these ceremonies.

Bob Spano mentioned that Wayne Williams was not able to attend tonight's meeting, but if any member had any completed scholarship applications to turn in, they were asked to turn them in to Bob Spano after the meeting. In addition, if any member wanted to apply for the National MCL scholarship program, give the member's name to Bob Spano and he will forward the information to Wayne Williams and the National Scholarship forms would be mailed to the member.

Announcements: It was mentioned that there is a need for a Color Guard on Friday evening, 21 April 2017, at the Paxon Hollow Country Club. Anyone interested should contact Bob

Spano after the meeting.
